Aluminum Banner Frame

GREAT AMERICAN'S BANNER FRAME:


- Portable frame can be moved to any location
- ★ Easy to assemble snaps together in minutes

Banner Frame Includes:

- A. 2 End Frames
- **B.** 2 Straight Poles (size varies)
- C. 2 End Posts
- D. 4 Plastic Spacers
- E. 4 Bolts
- F. 4 Nuts
- G. 2 Steel Ground Stakes
- H. 6 Bungee Cords








Ground Stake Installation:

- **1.** Determine where you want to display your banner and mark two spots approximately 10 ft 6 in apart (for BF5 frame). This is where you will install ground stakes.
- 2. Using a rubber mallet or hammer, pound the ground stakes (G) into the ground approximately 12-14". Make sure to leave at least 12-14" of the spike visible above ground.


Stake Installation Tips:

- Ensure that the installation of the spike is as vertical as possible. Using a rubber mallet is preferred.
- Do not drive spike into rocky ground or hardened soil. If soil is too dry, try soaking the area for a few minutes to soften it.
- Do not install in the way of any sprinkler systems or utility lines.



Frame Assembly:

- **1.** Slide one end of first pole (B) into the end of the end frame (A). Align the hole in the side of the end frame with the pin on the pole and push together until the pin pops through and they are secured.
- 2. Repeat with other pole and end frame.



- **3.** Align the pre-drilled holes on the assembled frame to the holes on one end post (C). Position a black plastic spacer (D) between the post and the frame. Slide one bolt (E) through the frame, spacer and post and secure with a nut (F). Repeat on other hole and with other post.
- **3.** Slide each end post of the assembled frame over an installed ground stake.

Hanging your Banner:

Slip one bungee cord (H) through one banner grommet and around the frame to secure. Repeat for all six grommets.
